

Engaging audiences with his charismatic and moving performances, pianist Aaron Kurz enjoys a burgeoning career. Kurz has performed across three continents, in venues such as Carnegie Hall, Salle Cortot, and the Palace of Peace and Harmony in Nur-Sultan, Kazakhstan. He has soloed with numerous orchestras, including the Fort Worth Symphony Orchestra, Shanxi Shuoze Symphony (China), and City of Cambridge (England) Symphony Orchestra. Kurz has also been a prizewinner in many competitions, such as the New York, Los Angeles, World Piano Teachers Association, and Virginia Waring International Piano Competitions. His performances have been lauded, with Belgium's *Le Soir* stating, "We'll remember...the musical journeys of a nuanced Aaron Kurz."

Mr. Kurz is currently studying at the San Francisco Conservatory with Jon Nakamatsu and Jeremy Denk, and he recently graduated from Yale, where he studied with Boris Berman. Other previous teachers include Carol Leone, Logan Skelton, Alexander Kobrin, Ian Jones, and Norma Fisher.
